

Vere Street, Collingwood – Asphalt resurfacing (Wellington Street to Harmsworth Street)

Works to be undertaken from Tuesday 9th of June 2020

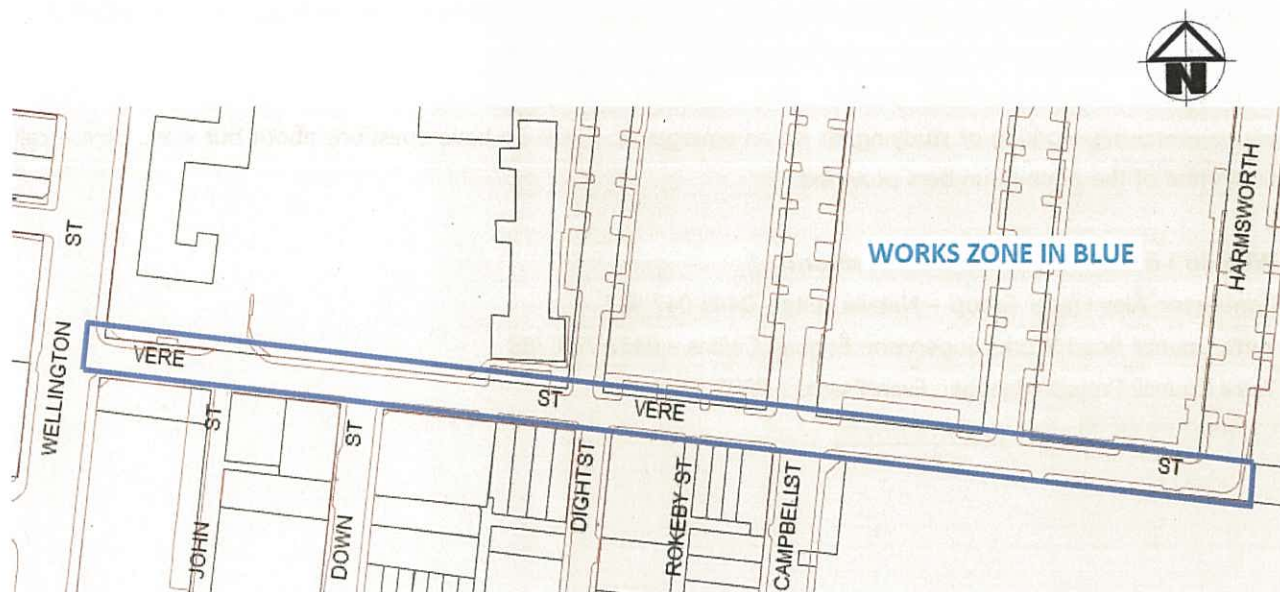
We will be carrying out work in your neighborhood soon and would like to share some important information.

What are we doing?

- Removing and resurfacing the asphalt road pavement.
- Adjustment of service pits and valves in the road to match the new asphalt surface as required.
- Linemarking installation to follow asphalt works.

Where are the works happening?

The works are happening in Vere Street, Collingwood from Wellington Street to Harmsworth Street:

When will the work take place?

Asphalt works will be undertaken from Tuesday 9th of June to Friday 12th of June. This is weather dependent.

Working hours are 7.00am to 5.00pm weekdays.

Linemarking will take place at a later date, following asphalt works.

There may be some noise and dust during the works, but we will try to keep this to a minimum.

Will I be able to access the street?

Vere Street will be closed during working hours. Traffic management will be in place with suitable detours.

Local residents will be able to access the road with the assistance of traffic controllers onsite.

Pedestrian access on Vere Street will be maintained.

Full road access to traffic will resume after 5:00pm. Some areas may remain barricaded overnight.

Where do I park my car?

Residents please park in nearby streets for the duration of the works.

Contact Council Road Works Supervisor listed below if you need a temporary parking permit. The permit must be placed on the dashboard of the car and be visible from outside. This will allow you to park in time restricted parking spaces in the vicinity of the road works without any time restrictions.

Parking will not be permitted in the works zone (on the road) in Vere Street during working hours.

Please note that vehicles parked in the works zone during works hours will be towed.

Please keep a safe distance

To help keep yourself and our workers safe and stop the spread of COVID-19 (coronavirus), we kindly ask that you follow the State Government's physical distancing requirements.

Make sure there is always 1.5 meters between you and another person, and remember not to be outside unless you're exercising, working or studying, or it's an emergency. If you do have questions about our work, please call us on one of the phone numbers provided.
