High Performance in Sport- USyd



The new major – High-Performance in Sport – will be available to students commencing from 2023 at USyd.

High-Performance sport knowledge offers potential to develop a career as a multi-disciplinarian (e.g., a coach; program manager) or specialist sports scientist (e.g., physiologist, biomechanist, psychologist, skillacquisitionist, strength & conditioner, nutritionist, or performance analyst).

USyd undergraduate degrees offering this major can be found here.

You will learn:

- How interdisciplinary factors influence high performance and the athletic development process.
- To apply measurement and testing techniques to evaluate athletic performance.
- To interpret athletic performance data, synthesise research evidence and practical knowledge, identify strategies/solutions to refine best practices, and design appropriate training/intervention programs.

Preparation Pathway to ADF

Have you completed Year 10 but didn't achieve the minimum requirements for the Australian Defence Force?

Or perhaps you are about to complete Year 10 this year and didn't take things as seriously as you needed?

Did you know there are vocational courses that give you the equivalent grade requirements to apply fir the ADF?

Approach your local TAFE or vocational campus and enquire.

Examples of full courses:

- Certificate II in Further Study Skills
- Certificate II in General Education for Adults

Or, you can consider a short course if you just need a boost in one subject area;

- Statement of Attainment in Defence Prep Maths
- Statement of Attainment in Defence Prep English
- Statement of Attainment in Defence Prep Science

Note if you wish to apply for a technical role you will need Science in addition to the English and Maths requirements. OTHER RANKS (TECHNICAL) For those seeking technical training

If you've completed Year 10 (or equivalent) with passes in English, Maths, Science and one other subject, you have a broad range of technical and trade apprenticeships to choose from in the ADF, and you'll be paid while you learn. Some trade roles also require Science with a Physics component so check individual job descriptions before starting your application.

Completion of Year 10 (or equivalent) with passes in English and Maths is the minimum educational requirement for a job in the ADF, and there are plenty of career opportunities to choose from. Some roles in this category require a pass in Year 10 Maths and Science, or passes in Year 11 (or equivalent) and above.
