Committee report

At the start of the year saw a change in Committee office bearers with Belinda Riseley and Ronnyne Magill resigning from their roles of President and Secretary. Belinda and Ronnyne were thanked for their time and work involved in the Committee over the past few years.

New office bearers took the reins, Bianca Lane took on the role as President and Jacklyn Lamb as Secretary.

As COVID restrictions eased further around the middle of the year this allowed more families to come onto school grounds and participate more in school activities.

This year the Committee's main focus was engaging further with the school community to build on the St Brendan's Primary School community spirit.

The Committee regularly engaged with the school community through the newsletter and other school communications, giving updates on events and advance notice of P&F events.

During the year a number of meetings were cancelled due to lack of interest by the school community to attend meetings. This made planning events and activities difficult.

The Committee has continually tried to seek feedback and suggestions from the school community.

It has been great to see the St Brendan's community spirit back after the uncertainty of the last few years. We look forward to continuing engagement with the school and school community to provide further opportunities for the children.

New initiatives

Electronic payment system

- Supported the school to introduce electronic payment method for use in fundraising to reduce cash handling.
- The school sought further advice from the Catholic Education Office and CDF Pay was introduced in Term 2 for use by families.

Increased communication with school community

- Regular information in fortnightly newsletter.
- Separate P&F Updates sent to families with SkoolBag app and email.

St Brendan's Feast Day Fun Run

- Feast Day was previously celebrated with a 'walk-a-thon' and hot dog lunch.
- Students enjoyed the fun run obstacle course on the school oval set up by Mr Wild with help from Year 6's.
- Students were also encouraged to raise funds to run laps of the course. A prize of \$100
 InterSport Shepparton voucher to the student who raised the most money overall. There
 were also two prize draws per year level for those who raised funds with prizes from
 Rebound and Collins Booksellers Shepparton, along with Encouragement Awards from
 Collins Booksellers Shepparton.
- The funds raised was just under \$1,000 from all students. This was the first time CDF Pay has been used for an event like this.

Athletes Foot Rewards Program

- Approached Athletes Foot management to sign up to rewards program. The school will earn \$5 from every shoe purchase where the link to St Brendan's PS is mentioned. A cheque will be presented to the school in April 2023.
- Program runs from December 2022 to April 2023, will promote at end of year and start of year period.
