

viC+orian premiers' Reading Challenge

We are excited to announce that Donvale Primary School will be participating in the Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge again this year. The Challenge is open to all Victorian children from birth to 16 years in recognition of the importance of reading for literacy development. It is not a competition; but a personal challenge for children to read a set number of books by the closing date of the challenge.

Children from Foundation to Year 2 are encouraged to read or 'experience' 30 books with their parents and teachers. Children from Year 3 to Year 6 are challenged to read 15 books. Each year level has books, which range from picture story to chapter books, with a variety of authors and categories.

Every student who successfully meets the challenge will receive a certificate and if permission is given, will have their name printed in The Age newspaper, which sponsors this competition.

Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge books are easily identifiable in libraries including our library at school as they have one of these stickers on them.



Many of you would also have Challenge books already in your book collection at home.

To access the Premiers' Reading Challenge website, students will need their own unique log in which will be sent home soon. This log in includes:

- Student Name
- Username
- Password (number)

- I. Go to the Premiers' Reading Challenge Challenge Application
- 2. Look at the Student section (top option).
- 3. Select the VPRC login option.
- 4. Enter your username and password.
- 5. Select Login
