SPX 2<sup>nd</sup> XI Premiership 2019/20

In the 2019/20 season, our 2<sup>nd</sup> XI finished the regular season at the top of the table after only dropping one game and went on to win the premiership – our first since 2017!!

St Pius X Cricket fields teams in both the ISA and Manly district competitions. There are two open teams (1st XI and 2nd XI) that play in Division 1 and 2 of the ISA competition, which include Sydney schools such as St Patricks College, Oakhill and St Gregory's, as well regional schools such as Scots All Saints, St Stanislaus and Chevalier.

Other teams, from U12 up to U16 play in the MWJCA competition, with games played on grounds in the Northern Beaches area, including Manly, Collaroy, Forestville and, of course, Oxford Falls.

#### This Season

MWJCA district games will commence in Term 4 (target start date is 17<sup>th</sup> October). This year, U14's to U16's will play on Saturday morning from 8am to 12noon. These will be one-day 30 over games played with the traditional 11 players per side.

In alignment with NSW Cricket policy, the U12's and U13''s will play a modified junior format, which is based one-day games only, teams of 9 players, and a shortened pitch. MWJCA will be likely running their U12 competition on a Saturday afternoon from 1pm, while U13's will likely remain in the morning (from 8am). Final timeslots will be confirmed by MWJCA once team numbers are known.

This season we expect to field at least one team in each of the age groups, from U12's through to U16's, with the possibility of two teams in some age groups. Teams will be generally organised by age group, with some boys playing up an age group to meet any representative qualifications, or to balance the team numbers. SPX teams may compete in either Division 1 or Division 2, with the intent being to place a team in the division where they will be most competitive.



If you are wanting to play SPX Cricket and have representative commitments with districts other than Manly, we can accommodate players being released from their SPX team in order to play the minimum number of qualification games for district representation. In this case, first priority for the bulk of the season, including finals, would remain with SPX Cricket.

There will be a Cricket Development day on Sunday, 13th September, to be held at Oxford Falls. Keep an eye on Woodchatta for age group timeslots.

#### **Covid-19 Safety Precautions**

#### Cricket Training

For boys interested in trialling for ISA this season, training commences on Monday, 7<sup>th</sup> September with net trials at Oxford Falls, and will then be twice a week on Monday and Wednesday from 14<sup>th</sup> September.

For district teams, training will be one afternoon per week at Oxford Falls (on a Tuesday or Thursday, depending on age group). Junior school boys (Years 5 and 6) will train during their Thursday afternoon sport. Keep an eye on Woodchatta for further details.
