TAFE NSW Start Your Future is an initiative of the NSW Government and part of the NSW Department of Education's Educational Pathways Program (EPP)

This program provides:

Practical demonstrations from highly qualified teaching staff and the opportunity for students to participate in hands on activities to gain insight and knowledge in the Civil Construction industry

Program outcomes include:

- Students make informed career choices to access Vocational Education and Training (VET) options
- Students develop individual learning plans identifying courses and study options linked to their preferred careers

Students will develop skills and knowledge in:

- · Work health and safety in a construction environment
- · How to safely maintain tools and equipment
- Working with hand tools and power tools
- Introduction to the construction industry
- Working with jackhammers, generators and vibratory compactors (wacka packas)
- · Introduction to levelling using laser levels and dumpy levels

Participant eligibility

Participants must be:

- A minimum 15 years of age
- attending EPP school
- likely to benefit from exposure to a vocational pathway
