Various instruments are available to students at ASPS:

GUITAR AND UKULELE (CONTEMPORARY)



As a working jazz guitarist, Felix has developed a contemporary guitar program to provide young students with the literacy and aural tools to allow them to speak and improvise the language of music fluently and navigate the diverse world of contemporary music with confidence.

The ukulele is also available as an instrument to learn, particularly for younger students, or to serve as a more casual introduction to contemporary music.

PIANO

Jennifer and Lucia are both classical pianists who have extensive experience with teaching younger students. The AMEB music and exam syllabus is available to students. While the AMEB music syllabus is often the default basis for lessons, more casual approaches to learning the piano are also available depending on the student's interests and requirements.



VIOLIN



Yeung is an experienced performer and music educator with extensive experience in teaching young violin students, from their early beginnings to advanced study of the instrument. Yeung teaches the AMEB music and exam syllabus.

Yeung also runs the ASPS String Ensemble program to provide classical string students (violin, viola, cello, double bass) with an early opportunity to perform in a string orchestra to supplement their on-going lessons and in preparation for High School orchestra.

WIND INSTRUMENTS (FLUTE, CLARINET, RECORDER & SAXOPHONE)

Chris has over 30 years of experience as a music educator of wind instruments. The classical AMEB syllabus for flute, clarinet, recorder and saxophone are available to students. However, Chris is also able to take a more contemporary approach with students, such as with the AMEB Saxophone for Leisure syllabus, or jazz and pop repertoires on the various instruments.
