UAC – 5 Things You Need to Know About EAS

The Educational Access Scheme (EAS) supports students whose studies have been significantly affected by difficult circumstances such as illness, hardship or disruption to learning. Through EAS, universities can take these challenges into account when assessing applications for university courses. Current Year 12 students intending to apply for EAS should ensure their application is submitted by **19 November 2026** to be considered for the main ATAR-based offer round on **23 December 2026**.

Students applying through CASAS must apply via UAC, list the relevant music degree as their first preference and complete an audition or portfolio submission directly with the Conservatorium.
