Extension of EAS to include additional COVID-19 payments

The Educational Access Scheme (EAS) will be extended to include applicants in Year 12 whose parent/s and/or guardian/s have received the COVID-19 Disaster Payment, JobSaver payments or Pandemic Leave Disaster Payment (to care for a COVID-19 positive person) for a period of 3 months or more. We encourage applicants to apply and upload documents to support these additional disadvantages under the category of financial hardship, code FO1K. The wording in the application will be updated shortly. Documents required are here.

That's why we offer UNSW Portfolio Entry, which gives you the opportunity to demonstrate your passion and talent, alongside your ATAR. If this sounds like you, we want to see your portfolio submission. It's an easy, online process, and can only ever boost your chances of admission. What you submit in your portfolio will depend on which degree you're interested in. Remember, your UNSW Portfolio Entry submission needs to be completed in addition to your UAC application. Please note, individual faculties may decide to open a second round to accommodate more applications after ATARs are released. The second round will be dependent on the number of places available in the program. Portfolio Entry gives you the opportunity to demonstrate your passion and talent, alongside your ATAR. UNSW Portfolio Entry is one, easy online process. You'll select up to three degrees that you're interested in and be guided through what you need to submit.
