
Reminders:

KEY CURRICULUM AREAS

Religion

Within **Religious Education**, we are learning about the Catholic Social Teachings. We are exploring the connection between The Ten Commandments (Exodus 20) and the Beatitudes (Matt 5:1-12) and how we can use these teachings in our lives today.



Literacy

In **Reading**, we are learning about sustainable farming practices and watching the documentary, 'Kiss The Ground' which teaches about the importance of the soil in reducing Global Warming. In the second half of the Term, we will explore the text 'Kensuke's Kingdom'. which follows the friendship of a boy named Michael and Kensukie, a Japanese World War II veteran. In this text we will explore their growing friendship along with themes including conservation and the importance of family.

Within **Writing**, we will focus on persuasive writing, including the use of high modality words such as 'must,' 'will and 'absolutely' and how to structure persuasive paragraphs.



Numeracy

This term in **Mathematics**, students will continue to build their recall of known facts through our Daily Review. We will begin the term with a focus on chance, review of fractions and an introduction to decimals. This will be followed with a focus on location followed by statistics. During the second half of the term, students will review multiplication and division, 3-Dimensional objects and addition and subtraction.

Throughout the term, students will have plenty of opportunities to practice new skills, while others will be extended to deepen their understanding. This

approach ensures that every child can progress at their own pace, whether they are mastering new concepts or furthering their existing knowledge.

Homework

All students are expected to read for at least 60 minutes each week. Please record their reading in their diary, sign it, and ensure it's handed to the teacher every Friday. We also encourage you to practise skip counting by 7s, 8s, and 9s, and to go over times tables with your child. These are important math skills we practise regularly at school and can easily be reinforced at home or even in the car to help build confidence and fluency.
