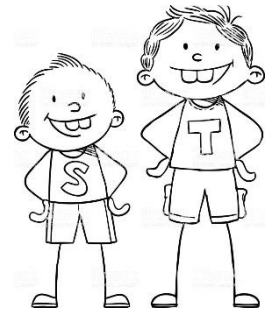

6. While swimming, Julia tried to swim across the 18-metre wide pool, but she only swam half way before she ran out of breath, and had to stand up in the pool. How far did she swim?
