The SHSAC has, and will remain an advisory board to support the Parish Priest and Principal in their decision making. The Board plays an advisory role in the areas of accountability, monitoring and supervision, strategy formulation and policy making in three key dimensions: Strategic Direction, Financial (Fiduciary) and Generative (Stewardship of vision/mission/community).

3 Key Roles - Responsibilities for School Advisory Councils

- 1. **Strategic** planning and improvement (linked to the Sandhurst Charter of Sandhurst School Improvement)
- 2. Fiduciary Government funds, fees, infrastructure
- 3. Generative giving life to people and their capacity (Stewardship Leadership focus)
