CHILD SAFETY CORNER: Why <u>Working With Children Check</u> (WWCC) and <u>Code of Conduct (COD)</u>? "Creating a culture of child safety within your organization is vital to lowering the risk of harm to children. Child abuse must be acknowledged, expectations of behaviour must be clearly explained and accepted [COD], and strategies such as robust recruitment practices must be in place [WWCC]. By building a strong culture of child safety, you will reduce the ability for potential abusers to be opportunistic. There should be a high expectation that everyone in your organization is committed to child safety. This needs to be led and facilitated by your leadership and should be consistent with your organisation's aims and values."
