

Change your future with FlexiTrack High

Murdoch University's FlexiTrack High program can help provide an entry pathway into Murdoch University for aspiring students who may not be on track to achieve an ATAR.

Murdoch University works with participating FlexiTrack High secondary schools to provide a structured and supportive learning experience for students seeking an alternative option to the ATAR entry pathway into university.

FlexiTrack High is designed utilising the most effective evidence-based teaching and learning approaches. It aims to prepare students for undergraduate studies at Murdoch University by:

- Providing explicit instruction in the foundational academic skills of reading, writing, analysing and researching
- Developing capacity to engage critically with texts and argue effectively.

How it works

Over a period of 30 weeks, FlexiTrack High focuses on developing a student's academic skills as well as the self-regulation and independent learning competencies needed to successfully undertake tertiary study.

- FlexiTrack High is a blended, collaborative learning model.
- A minimum 4-hour weekly teaching period is assigned in the students' school timetable.
- Teacher facilitators are provided with a learning plan to guide the use of time during the allotted timetabling.
- Murdoch University tutors guide and assess the student learning experience.

Flexi Track High Course structure

Students will complete 1 core unit and 1 specified elective unit. We recommend students choose a specified elective unit that is related to their preferred undergraduate course at Murdoch.

Core units

- UPP011 – FlexiTrack High

Specified elective

- UPP005 – Introduction to Health Professions
- UPP006 – Introduction to Education
- UPP007 - Introduction to Criminology and Digital Media: Fake News, Cults, Crimes and Celebrity

- Fees are \$1,200 (GST inclusive) and are paid at the time of enrolment.
- Fee exempt equity places are available to eligible students upon school recommendation.
