Works notification

Marshall Station Bus Loop Temporary Closure

28 November – 12 December 2024

Major construction on the South Geelong to Waurin Ponds Duplication is complete, with two dangerous level crossings removed and the rebuild of two stations for passengers on Victoria's busiest regional rail line.

Further works need to occur on the bus loop at Marshall Station, which will be temporarily closed from **Thursday, 28 November to Thursday, 12 December 2024.**

What we're doing

Further asphalt works will be occurring on the bus loop at Marshall Station, which will be closed to buses from **Thursday, 28 November to Thursday, 12 December.**

Temporary bus stops will be in place on Marshalltown Road during this period. Refer to page 2 for a map.

What to expect

Works will occur on the bus loop Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm with traffic management in place for the safety of workers and the public. The bus loop will remain closed on the weekend.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times between the temporary bus stops on Marshalltown Road and the station.

Please follow directional signage in place for the location of bus stops and safe entry and exit points to the station precinct.
