

How To Make A Worm Tunnel St Mary's Style



Materials:

- Your ready made St Mary's Worm Tunnel -A recycled plastic plant pot (30cm) - You will notice there are drilled holes in the sides and the base has been cut off.
- Worms
- Ceramic Saucer (30cm or more)
- Newspaper

Instructions

Step 1 - Choose an area in your garden where you would like to place your worm tunnel.

Step 2- Dig a hole large enough to fit your worm tunnel.

Step 3- Position your worm tunnel snugly in the hole.



Step 4- Refill the tunnel with soil and add in your St Mary's compost and worms. Allow enough room for your kitchen scraps.



Step 5- Add your kitchen scraps. You will need to do this at least once a week.



Step 6- Make a worm blanket out of a folded piece of damp newspaper. Hessian also makes a great worm blanket. Place the worm blanket over the food scraps. This creates a dark and damp environment for the worms.

Step 7- Place the ceramic saucer on the worm tunnel. This will be used as a lid.

Step 8- Relax whilst our St Mary's worms do their work!
