Dear Parent,

Would **\$500.00** help cover the cost of uniforms, iPad/laptop, lunch boxes, excursions or pay for swimming lessons?

You or someone you know may be eligible to join a local savings program and receive \$500 for education expenses.

Berry Street is delivering Saver Plus in the Greater Shepparton area!

Saver Plus is a 10-month program that can assist you to save for your own or your children's education. Participants receive:

- one dollar in matched savings from ANZ for every one dollar you save, up to \$500
- Free MoneyMinded financial workshops

At the end of the program you can use your matched savings to purchase an education-related item, such as a computer, laptop, school camps/excursions and text books.

To be eligible to participate in Saver Plus you must:

- be 18 years or over;
- be a parent or guardian of a student attending school, or be attending or returning to vocational training yourself;
- have a current health care card or pensioner concession card;
- Have some form of household income, for example, your partner or you may have casual, part-time, full-time or seasonal employment.
- Be on a commonwealth payment. This includes family tax benefit, child care rebate etc.
