
#### **General Instructions**

- 1. Students wear PE gear including full tracksuit to school on Friday August 13.
- 2. Bags with of camp gear may be kept in Mr Miller's office during the day if you wish.
- Students collect bags immediately at the end of the school day and move to the bus which departs at 3.20 Which will be in the temporary bus circular drive.
  - You will need to take your school bag to the camp. We will be staying in the Aviary dormitories.
- 4. The full camp program handbook will be distributed prior to the camp.
- 5. The camp will conclude at 2.30pm on Saturday and the bus should return to school by 3pm.
- 6. Mobile Phones are permitted at camp but must not be used at any session without permission.



#### **Special Instructions and rules:**
