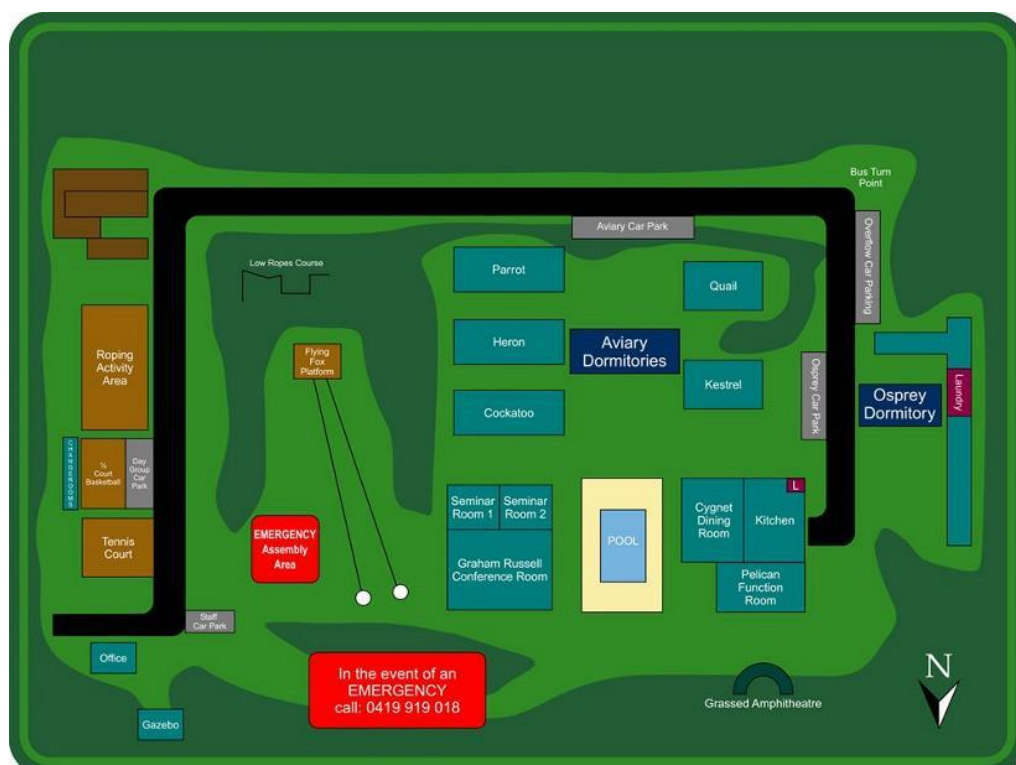
### General Instructions

1. Students wear PE gear including full tracksuit to school on Friday August 13.
2. Bags with of camp gear may be kept in Mr Miller's office during the day if you wish.
3. Students collect bags immediately at the end of the school day and move to the bus which departs at 3.20  
Which will be in the temporary bus circular drive.  
You will need to take your school bag to the camp. We will be staying in the **Aviary dormitories**.
4. The full camp program handbook will be distributed prior to the camp.
5. The camp will conclude at 2.30pm on Saturday and the bus should return to school by 3pm.
6. Mobile Phones are permitted at camp but must not be used at any session without permission.

### Special Instructions and rules:

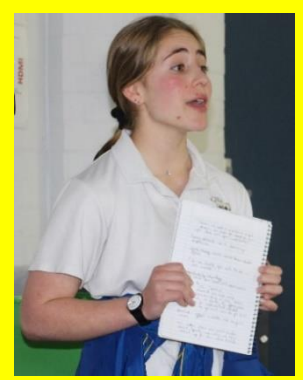
1. The highest standard of cooperation is required at all times with all presenters and supervisors
