I write to invite you to participate in the ECSI survey which will assist us in better understanding how our Catholic Identity is expressed in our work and practice here at Galilee.

The Catholic University in Leuven, Germany, was commissioned by the Catholic Education Commission of Victoria Ltd (CECV) to design a process and tools, based on sound research, to accomplish the goal of understanding our current Catholic identity and where the school community might like to see itself in the future.

Please note, for ease of completion of the survey, **E1362** is the Entry code for our school. Please also answer NO to the question: *Are you a student?*

The survey is only available through the project website. Please refer to the 'Instructions for Survey Completion for Parents'. Your responses to this survey are anonymous and guaranteed as such by the Survey Developer and our school.
