# 2021 Year 9 NAPLAN Timetable



Year 9 students will complete NAPLAN testing from Tuesday 11 – Thursday 13 May 2021.

NAPLAN tests are designed to assess students' proficiency in Literacy and Numeracy. Students at St Gregory's College will be completing the paper version of the test.

## **NAPLAN** Instructions

## Test materials.

Students will need to bring a pencil, eraser and a pen (blue/black) to each test. They will also need a calculator for the Numeracy test on Thursday. These items are to be placed in a clear container/plastic envelope or small pencil case. Students may also bring in a clear drink bottle. No other material will be allowed into the room.

#### Digital equipment.

Students will not be permitted to bring digital equipment into the examination room except for their calculator. Students will need to leave their mobile phone, smart watch, laptop and any other equipment in their locker or bag.

#### Silence.

Students will need to remain silent during all tests. If assistance is needed, students are to raise their hand and wait for the supervisor. Students should not attempt to communicate with any other students during the test, even when papers are being collected.

#### Toilet breaks.

Students will not be permitted to go to the bathroom in the first 30 minutes or the last 30 minutes of any test.

#### Normal Timetabled lessons.

Normal timetabled lessons will take place when tests are not scheduled and students will need to bring in their equipment for these lessons.

#### Absence during a test.

If a student is absent and misses a NAPLAN test, the College will endeavor to schedule a catch-up exam on the student's next day of school after he has completed his next NAPLAN test. If a student is absent on Thursday or has not caught up on other NAPLAN tests, he will need to attend school on Friday during the Parent, Teacher Student Interviews to complete his tests. If a student will miss a NAPLAN test, his parent/carer is to contact the Academic Care Leader (Ms Keir) before the test commences.
