# Selection Process for the EIS program:

Students will be required to participate in both fitness and skills testing sessions for the EIS programs. The participation in these sessions along with the completion of the application form will be used to rank students. These rankings along with reference to the students Progress Reports will be used to decide the selection of students into the programs.

## **Fitness and Skills Testing:**

The fitness and skills testing sessions will be held during week 7 of Term 2. The fitness testing involves completing the Beep Test, Vertical Jump Test and 20M Sprint Test. The skills testing sessions involve the students completing a skill-based training session along with competitive match simulations.

#### **Cost of the Program:**

The fees for the EIS programs are \$250 for your first year in the program and \$150 for every year after. The fees are used to purchase personal training uniforms for the students. As well as, specialised training equipment, competitions and excursions throughout the year.

### How will I know if my EIS application was successful or not?

Students will be notified via email if they were successful or not in their application. Please hold off completing your subject selections until you know if you can select the EIS program or not.

Being selected into the EIS program means you have a position in the program for that calendar year. You do not automatically get accepted into the program the following year. Student's are required to maintain a minimum behaviour and participation standard. Students who fail to meet these standards will forfeit their place in the program when deemed by Lilydale High School.
