LIVING AND WORKING IN AUSTRALIA

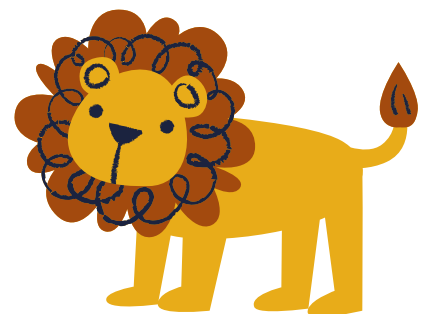
