## HOUSE TEAMS

## TIMES

## RULES

- 1 Gear check required before competing in each test. Incorrect gear may result in Elimination.
- 2 All competitors will be required to wear an EA safety approved helmet, boots, jodhpurs and house sports shirt. A house-coloured jumper is encouraged as are coloured saddlecloths and browbands.  
\*Jodhpurs – beige, banana, mango or cream.
- 3 A horse may be ridden by two competitors if it is hired by more than one horsemanship student and with the permission of Mrs Prosser or the horses' owner.
