
Good News Story

Last year was a tough one to say the least. COVID-19 turned the world upside down and made our lives extremely difficult with many losing their jobs. On the other hand it brought communities together and showed us the true colours of each and every person. Here at Djerriwarrh Community House we were fortunate to be part of the Melton Local Project which provided much needed food relief packages and COVID Safe information to those that were hit hard by the virus.

In the months from December to February we have helped over 200 families put food on the table. The packages included staples like rice, flour, sugar and pasta and some goodies for the children such as juice boxes and potato chips. The families were also given a voucher to shop for perishable items such as eggs, milk and groceries.

JOB TRAINER INTIATIVE- Have you heard?

The JobTrainer Initiative (JobTrainer) is a joint Commonwealth and State Initiative which provides additional funding to increase access to free or low fee training places for young people and job seekers. If you are between 17 - 24 of age OR a Job Seeker, you may be *eligible for a concession fee* (up to 80% fee reduction may apply for accredited courses). Under the new JobTrainer initiative, "subsidised training places are available to young people and job seekers, even if they don't meet the 'upskilling' or 'two at level in lifetime' eligibility requirements. *Limited spots available* so please call us at 03 8746 1000 or email us at training@djerriwarrh.org for more information.

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ADULT MIGRANT ENGLISH PROGRAM (AMEP)

The Adult Migrant English Program (AMEP) provides up to 510 hours of free English language tuition to eligible migrants and humanitarian entrants. AMEP is funded by the Australian Government Department of Home Affairs. AMEP helps clients to learn English as well as to participate socially and economically in Australian society.

You may be eligible for AMEP if you have been

- granted a permanent visa OR
- granted an eligible temporary visa AND
- speak little or no English

Young people between 15 and 17 years of age may also be eligible.

In an AMEP class you will learn English language skills and information about Australian society.

You can meet other people learning English. Classes are taught by qualified teachers. For further information about AMEP please contact us.
