



Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge 2025

The Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge is now open and Mt. Eliza Primary School is excited to be participating. The PRC application offers a range of exciting features including:

- access to a library catalogue (including book images and blurbs)
- a modern user-friendly interface
- rewarding students with badges as challenge milestones are achieved
- the option for students to mark books as a favourite, give them a star rating or complete a book review

The Challenge is open to all Victorian children from birth to Year 10 in recognition of the importance of reading for literacy development. It is not a competition; but a personal challenge for children to read a set number of books **by Friday 5th September 2025.**

Number of books students need to read or 'experience' with their parents and teachers:

Prep to Year 2

Number of books: 30

Number of books from the Challenge book list: 20 or more

Year 3 to Year 6

Number of books: 15

Number of books from the Challenge book list: 10 or more

All children who meet the Challenge will receive a certificate of achievement signed by the Victorian Premier and former Premiers.
