

KNOX PREP COVID-19 SPORTS FIXTURES PROTOCOLS

Updated 20 July 2020

The following protocols have been put in place to ensure the safety of all players, staff and parents attending school sport at Knox Prep.

SPECTATORS

- You must pre-register to attend as a spectator by going to https://www.knox.nsw.edu.au/community/parent-resources/prep-covid-19-sports-hub/
- One parent only will only be able to attend the sports fixture for their son.
- We are unable to welcome students, siblings, Old Boys, other parents).
- Registration will be via Humanitix (for Privacy Policy, please see https://console.humanitix.com/public/pdfs/humanitix_privacy_policy.pdf)
- Information will be collected only for the purposes of the sport fixture and contact tracing. Your contact details will not be used for marketing purposes.
- Spectators will not be permitted to enter the campus if they have tested positive to COVID-19, are unwell and showing flu-like symptoms or have been in close contact with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- Spectators will not be permitted to enter the campus if they have been in any part of Victoria within the last 14 days.
- Entry points will be limited. Please see the venue maps at https://www.knox.nsw.edu.au/community/parent-resources/prep-covid-19-sports-hub/
- Spectators will be required to have their registration ticket scanned upon entry to the campus.
- Spectators will be required to sanitise their hands upon entry.
- Each venue will have spectator limits based on the 4m2 rule.
- Spectators are expected to maintain 1.5m physical distancing from all people other than their family and, if sitting, are to ensure at least one seat separation between them and others.
- Spectators are asked to leave immediately after the conclusion of the game.
- Staff will be on site to ensure spectators comply with these rules and to ensure the safety of the Knox and opposition school communities.

PLAYERS

- Players, coaches and medical staff are not required to pre-register to attend.
- All players are to arrive in their playing attire.
- There will be no sharing of jerseys.
- All players are to bring their own water bottle (with name clearly marked) no sharing, please.
- Players are asked to refrain from shaking hands after their game.
- Balls will be washed before and after warmup, before games, at half time and after games.

FOOD, DRINKS AND AMENITIES

- Canteens, food stores and barbeques will not be open on campus.
- Bathrooms will be open and will be professionally cleaned on a regular basis.
