Religion

In this unit students learn about the Holy Spirit in Scripture and through an introduction to the study of Confirmation. They learn of the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit. They begin to explore Confirmation as a sacrament and a celebration. At the conclusion of this unit students explore ways in which they can use their gifts and talents to serve God and others

Integrated Inquiry

It's all about science this term!

The students will be involved in a range of experiments involving:

- reversible and irreversible changes
- refraction, reflection and absorption of light
- creating open and closed circuits

We will examine how to conduct experiments safely and how to record our observations and results accurately.

English

The students will be continuing with their Literature Circle rotations this term on a Thursday morning. In conjunction with this, students will also be developing their ability to take notes from oral sources and reading and interpreting a variety of text types. Students will be looking at Greek myths and will start to write their own Quest narratives.

One of the highlights of their term will also be the culmination of the Debating Program, when the students present their debates to the parents (and an adjudicator from the Debating Association of Victoria) during the Debating night.

Mathematics

The students will be continuing to focus on developing their skills in fractions, decimals and percentages. They will explore Chance experiments and explain their reasoning using their knowledge of fractions, decimals and percentages. In conjunction with participating in the Mini Mission Fete, students will explore money, focusing on calculating discounts on purchases. In the area of measurement, students will learn about location and angles.

It is important that students continue to strengthen their number facts and multiplication tables. Remember - Mathletics is always a fantastic resource to use at home.
