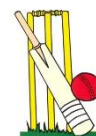


Viewing Academic Reports

- Click on the name of the Semester Report cycle to view and download a copy of the PDF report

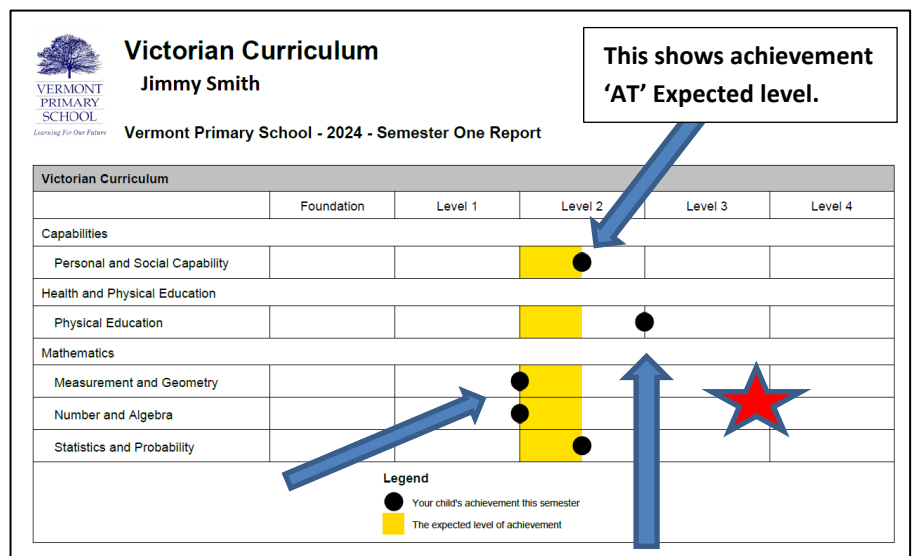


How to read my child's report?

You will see a list of all the subjects that your child has been taught this semester. The Report will indicate your child's achievement this semester.

The yellow shaded area shows the expected standard of students at **this time of year**. For Example: if you see a black dot (a Progression Point) either at the beginning or end of the yellow shaded area, it means that your child is 'AT' the 'Expected Level' in this subject.

If your child is outside this yellow area, it means that they are Below or Above the expected level in that particular subject.



The illustration above shows how the previous year's reports were presented for mathematics. It showed the three Mathematics strands of *Measurement and Geometry*, *Number and Algebra* and *Statistics and Probability*.


This year, the 2025 Semester One Reports will be reporting to the Mathematics 2.0 Curriculum, where just **one** overall achievement mark will appear. Please read on for details.

2025 Mathematics Curriculum 2.0 Reporting Update

The Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority (VCAA) recently published its revised mathematics curriculum (Mathematics curriculum 2.0).




All Victorian government schools will start using the Mathematics curriculum 2.0 in 2025. At Vermont Primary School we are using the revised mathematics curriculum for school reporting from Semester One 2025.

On your child's previous report, the teacher reported against the 3 strands of the achievement standard for mathematics (Number and Algebra, Measurement and Geometry, and Statistics and Probability). Under the Mathematics curriculum 2.0, your child's teacher will report against the achievement standard as a whole, providing a single, aggregated score.

As the achievement standards reported on have changed, the first time you receive a report under the Mathematics 2.0 curriculum, it will only show achievement and not progress. For all reports after this, progress will be shown against the single achievement standard.

Unlike the English Curriculum which will show achievement and progress. See below: it indicates the 6 month progress.

The VCAA made these changes to Mathematics to help teachers plan their teaching and learning programs, giving them more flexibility to support students to link ideas within mathematics and also with other curriculum areas.
