





What's been happening around Wembley?

2: In Prep, we have been learning about numbers 1-10! We have been practising connecting number names to their numerals.











3: We have been practising writing our names with magnetic letters each morning in Prep.






1 & 2: The Year Two's have been working through the writing process and have created wonderful narratives.

1: In Year 4, we are writing Found Poetry based on the award winning William Steig book Doctor De Soto.



2: Year 6 have been studying texts by Gary Crews and 6A created some found poetry.





3 & 6: Our new Borrow & Play equipment system is up and running! Thank you to our upper school student leaders and volunteers for getting this off the ground!
