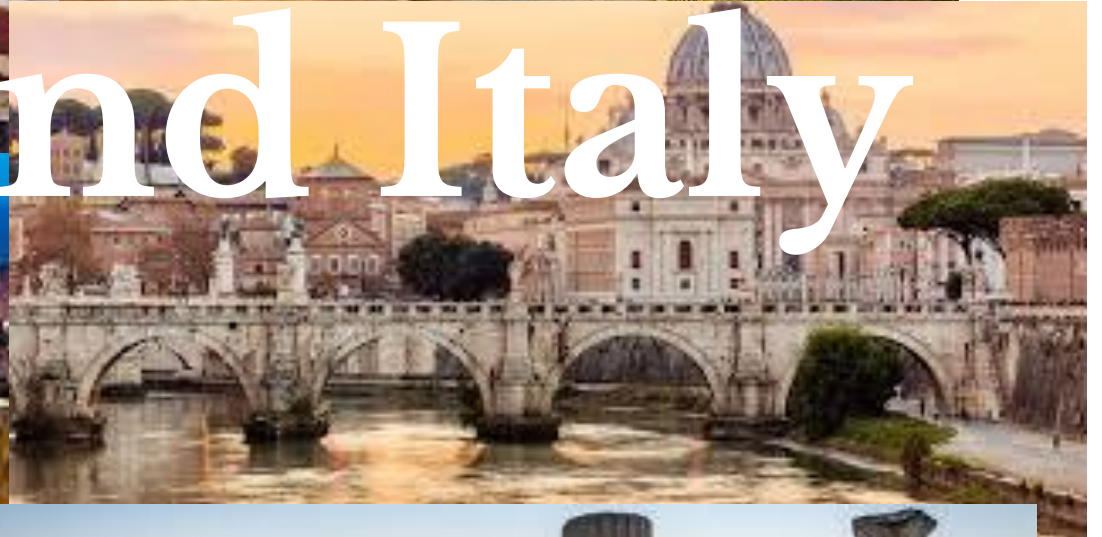

- Please check for potential entry/visa requirements, these are the responsibility of the family

Spending money

- Lunches, drinks and snacks
- Shopping and souvenirs



Medical requirements
