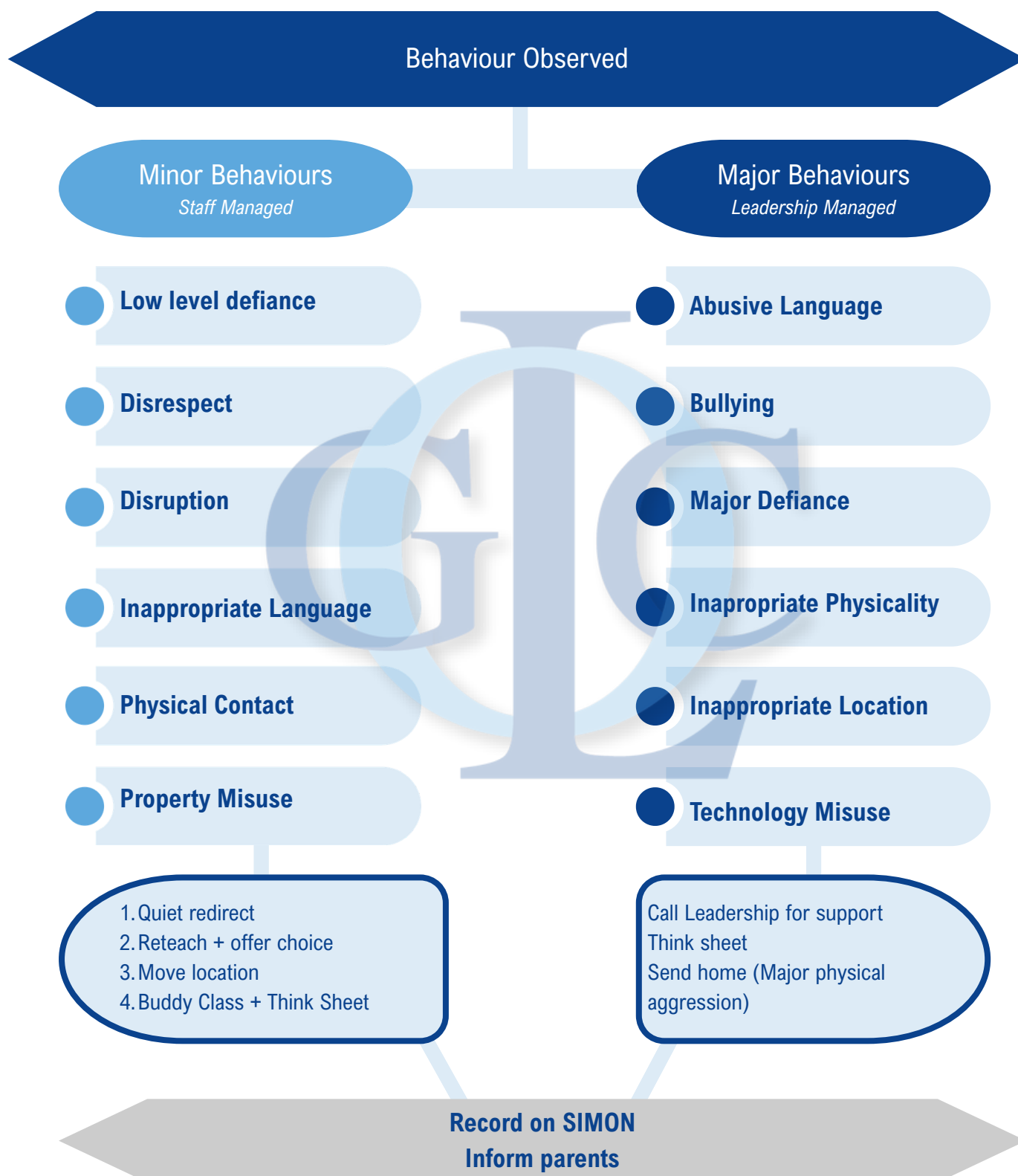


OLGC Behaviour Flowchart

Purpose: This flowchart supports all staff at Our Lady of Good Counsel to respond to student behaviour consistently, fairly, and in keeping with our school values. By clearly distinguishing between minor behaviours managed by classroom teachers and major behaviours requiring leadership involvement, we ensure every student receives a timely, proportionate response that prioritises learning, dignity, and restoration. Consistent use of this framework builds a safe and predictable environment where all members of our community can thrive.



Minor Behaviours		
Behaviour demonstrated	Description	Examples
Low level defiance	Brief or low-intensity failure to follow directions or talking back.	-talking back -ignoring instructions -talking over teacher
Disrespect	Low-intensity, rude or dismissive messages to adults or students.	-Talking over teacher -rolling eyes -muttering comments
Disruption	Low-intensity interruption of class or school activities.	-talking over teacher -leaving classroom without permission -moving around the classroom during lesson
Inappropriate Language	Low-intensity harmful language.	-shut up -idiot -stupid - what the –
Physical Contact	Non-serious, physical contact that violates school guidelines.	-accidental physical touch -not being aware of body (in line and in classroom) -tagging too hard
Property misuse	Low-intensity incorrect use of materials or property.	-breaking pencils/rulers -drawing on tables -taking things off other's desks

Major Behaviour		
Behaviour demonstrated	Description	Examples
Abusive Language	swearing, name calling or using words in an inappropriate way	-swearing at the teacher -threats -personalised or specific -discrimination
Bullying	direct or technology based messages that involve intimidation, teasing, taunting, threats or name calling	-discrimination -threats -online bullying -consistent excluding -racism
Major Defiance	refusal to follow directions or talks back	-running away -threatening to leave school -climbing school fence -massive outburst -refusing to leave classroom
Disrespect	socially rude or dismissive messages	-see above -excluding others
Inappropriate Display of Affection	inappropriate, consensual verbal and/pr physical gestures/contact, of a sexual nature	-touching private areas -kissing
Inappropriate Location	In an area that is outside of school boundaries	-jumping the fence -dumpster area -refusing to get out of tree -inside during breaks -toilets
Lying or Cheating	Delivers messages that are untrue	-using AI -copying other students -lying about incidents
Physical Aggression	serious physical contact where injury may occur	-hitting -spitting -biting -kicking
Property Damage	destruction of property	-breaking windows -stepping on laptops/ipads -graffiti Throwing rocks
Technology Misuse	Violation of digital technology agreement	-visiting inappropriate sites -playing games during work times -sending threatening messages
