



Clipboard: A Guide to Logging In for Parents and Carers

Clipboard is a new software platform the College has engaged to help our community manage our co-curricular program. This software enables students and families to sign up for activities including sporting teams, performing arts ensembles, music tuition, debating and a whole range of immersion programs.

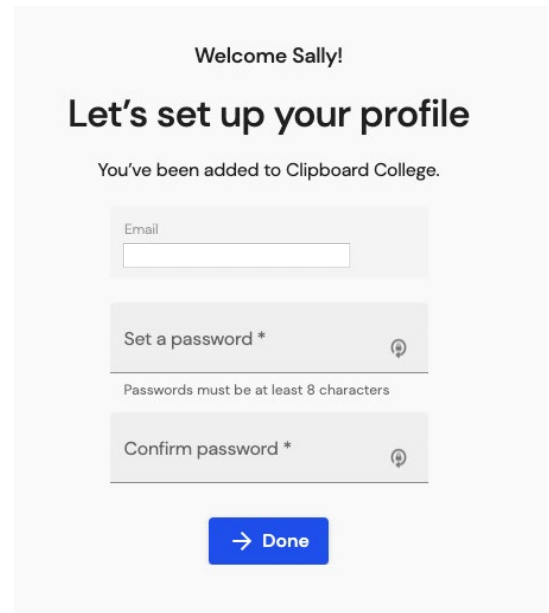
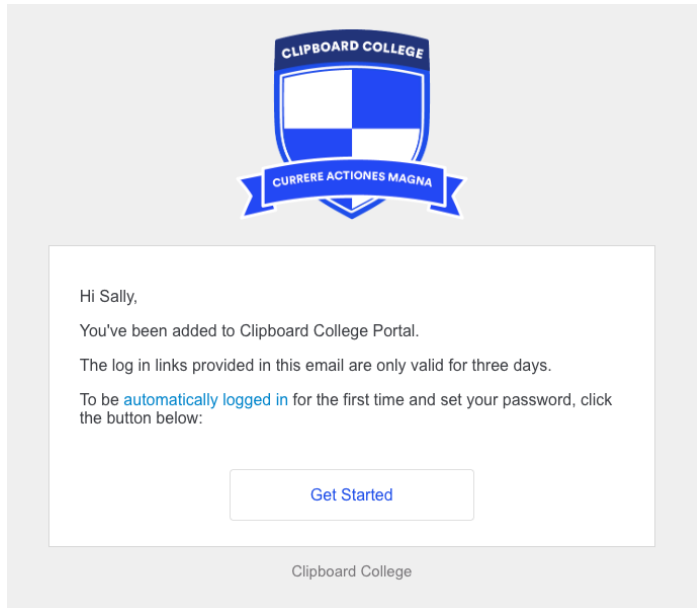
The College has created an account for each student and one Parent/Carer. The details provided for the Parent/Carers labelled Parent 1 on the College enrolment form have been used to create the Parent Clipboard account. This is also the Parent/Carers email address used by the College for most emails and contacts.

This document outlines how to access Clipboard and sign in.

Using Email and Password

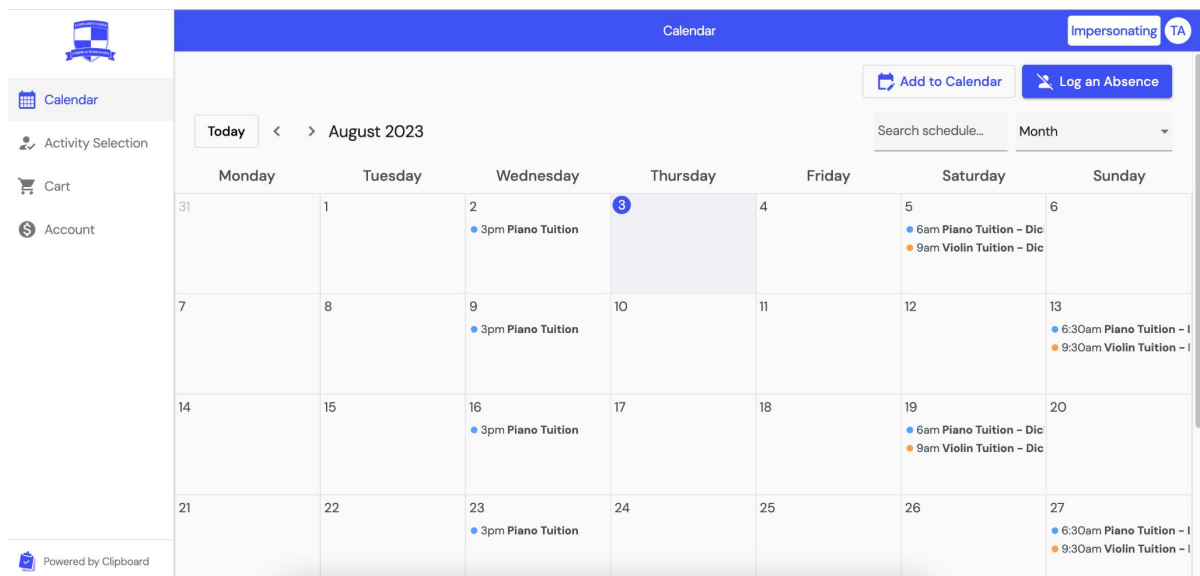
Once you have received an invite email to your school's Clipboard Portal, you will be prompted to start by logging in for the first time and setting a password as seen below.

The screenshots below are examples using the Clipboard College Portal. The email you shall receive should be reflective and branded to your school.



After you have set up your password, you can log into the Portal (portal.clipboard.app/stpiusx) with your email address and password.

After you have successfully logged in, you will now be able to view the Portal! The screen should look similar to the one below.





Adding Clipboard to your Apple Device

Want to download the Clipboard Portal as an app? There isn't a downloadable app for users. However, the Clipboard Portal is mobile-friendly and appears as an app when you open it in a web browser on your mobile! You can add it to your mobile home screen for ease of access.

To add the Portal to your Apple mobile home screen:

1. Open your Safari web browser and login to your schools Portal (portal.clipboard.app/stpiusx).
2. Tap the browser menu icon (in the case of Apple, the symbol is a square with an arrow pointing up inside it



Select Add to Home Screen. You'll then be able to enter a name for the shortcut and add it to your home screen.

Now the Clipboard Portal will show up just like any other app on your phone, easily accessible from anywhere.

Android: Adding the Portal to your Mobile Home Screen

Want to download the Clipboard Portal as an app? There isn't a downloadable app for users. However, the Clipboard Portal is mobile-friendly and appears as an app when you open it in a web browser on your mobile! You can add it to your mobile home screen for ease of access.

To add the Portal to your Android mobile home screen:

1. Open your Chrome web browser and login to your school's Portal (portal.clipboard.app/stpiusx)
2. Tap your browser menu icon (in the case of Chrome, the symbol is 3 vertical dots)



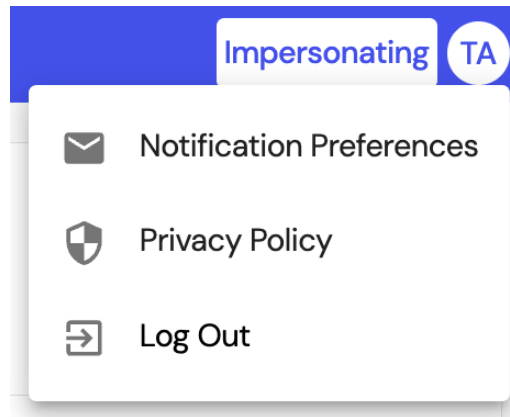
3. Select Add to Home Screen. You'll then be able to enter a name for the shortcut and add it to your home screen.

Now the Clipboard Portal will show up just like any other app on your phone, easily accessible from anywhere!



Managing Your Notifications

To make changes to what you would like to be notified about, you can log into the Clipboard Portal and click on Notification Preferences in the top right corner under your profile.



You can see the notifications you are currently subscribed to under Notification Preferences.

Push Notifications

A push notification is a message that pops up on a mobile device and appears like SMS text messages and mobile alerts.

You can receive push notifications directly through Clipboard. These Push Notifications will only reach users **who have access to the Clipboard Portal with push notifications enabled**. Clipboard push notifications will only reach users who have enabled them.

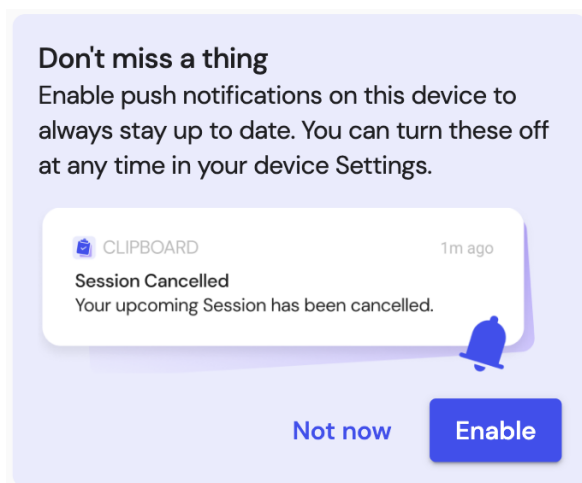

When are push notifications sent?

- When a new Session or Fixture has been created.
- When a Session or Fixture has been cancelled.
- When a Session or Fixture has changed the:
 - Date
 - Time
 - Location

How to ensure I will receive push notifications?

On your mobile device, follow the prompts provided by your 'Don't miss a thing' pop-up to enable notifications. See the example of the pop-up in the image below.



Your browser will give you permission to Clipboard to show notifications. Click 'allow' or 'confirm' for these notifications.

You will now start receiving notifications on your phone for events in Clipboard! It's that easy!

Troubleshooting Push Notifications:



1. What to do if you are not presented with the above card?

Please try the following steps to resolve this issue:

- Update your device. iOS requires 16.4 or above; Android supports this on older versions, but this differs per device.
- Install the app on your home screen first. Some devices will only allow notifications when installed on the home screen. Please see our articles on how to add this to your [Apple](#) and [Android](#) device.
- You may have dismissed the card; please log out and log back in to view it again.
- Check to see if you have blocked Clipboard permissions for these notifications.
