School Performance Parent Information

Dear Parents,

Our preparations for our concert 'A World for Everyone - The Journey of a Magic Suitcase' are coming along really well and the excitement is certainly building! Please refer to the information below for details that are important to note for the concert evenings.

Ticket Sales

- We have approximately 250 tickets remaining and these will be advertised for sale shortly via Operoo. We have decided to make an additional two tickets available to our Year 5 and 6 families as of Friday afternoon, and the remainder of the school community as of Monday. This is due to the following factors;
 - Our current Yr 5 & 6 students missed a school concert in Year 1 & 2 due to COVID restrictions. (This is only the second school concert for our Year 5 students.)
 - Yr 5 & 6 students have the main character roles.
 - This is the final concert for the Yr 5 & 6 students whilst at St James.

Arrival

- Students are required to arrive at Crossways between 6:15- 6:30pm, entering via the back door near the playground and green slide. Please refer to the attached map for the exact location.
- After drop-off, families may enter through the main foyer entrance at the front of the building.
- Students do not need to bring jackets or drink bottles with them into the theatre room. We kindly ask parents to hold on to these items so they can be returned to the child after the concert if needed. We will have water available for students to drink if required.

Departure

- At the conclusion of the concert production all students will be on the main stage. Dave will firstly
 ask the Prep parents to come to the stage to collect their child and any other siblings. Dave will
 then proceed to ask parents of Year 1 students to collect their child and any siblings from the
 stage. From there, he will continue to ask parents from the other levels to do the same.
- Please note that if you are not attending as an audience member on a particular night, you may
 gather in the foyer from 8:40 pm and the doors will be opened up for you to enter the auditorium,
 and collect your child when the concert is finished.

Costume & Make Up

- Students will need to arrive at Crossway wearing their costume as outlined by your child's classroom teacher. Some costumes will be handed out by staff when your child arrives at Crossway.
- All children are encouraged to wear foundation, mascara and a pink or red toned coloured lipstick or gloss for video and lighting purposes.
