current restriction guidelines.

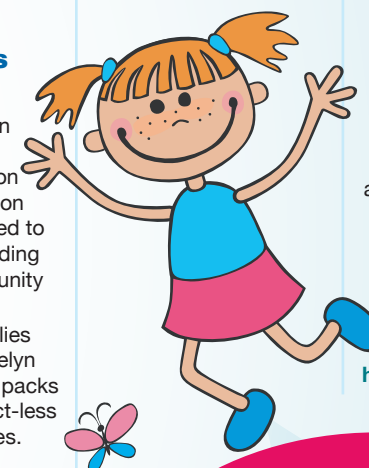
