## Classroom 2P



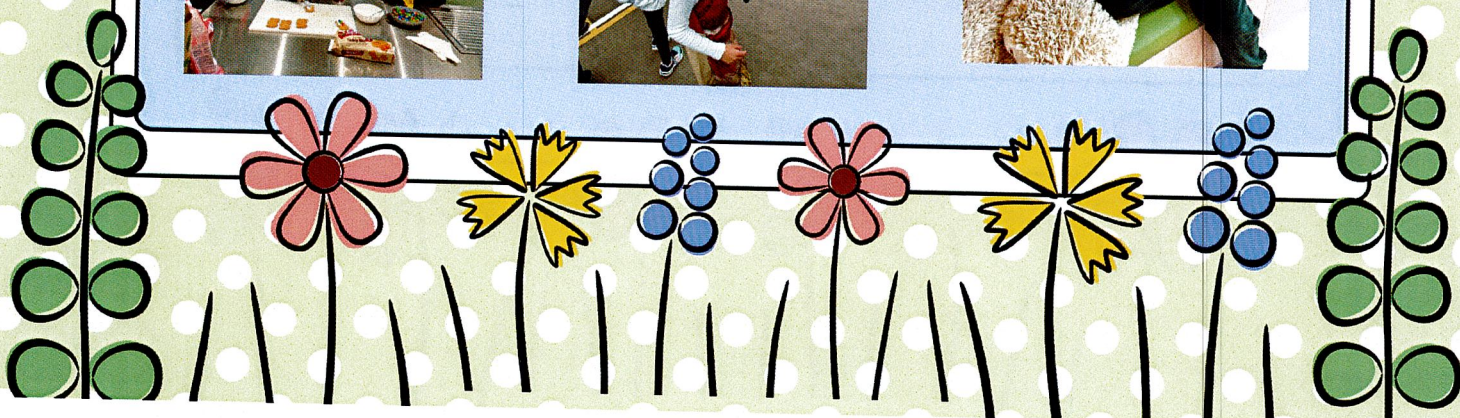
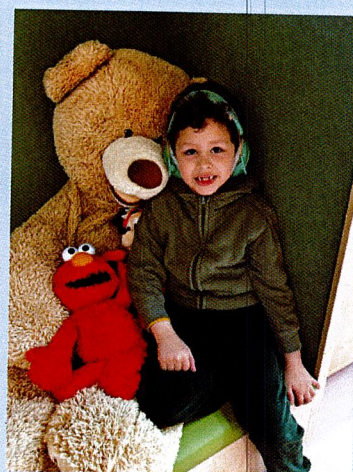
2P have had another fantastic and busy term filled with learning and lots of exciting experiences.

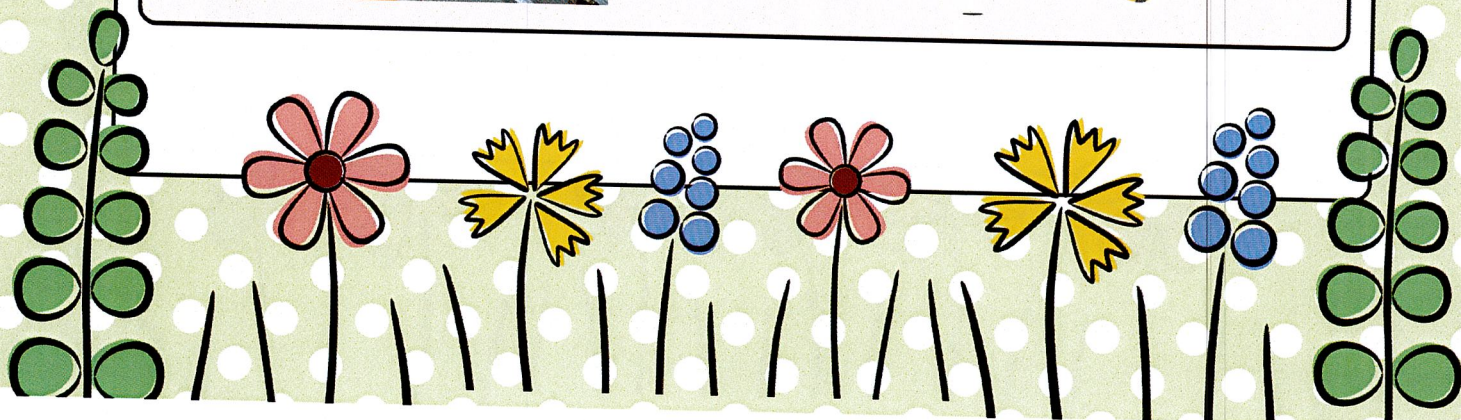
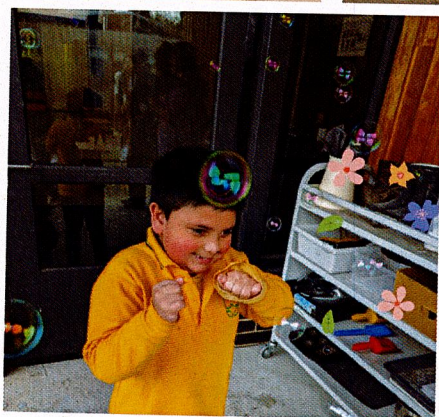
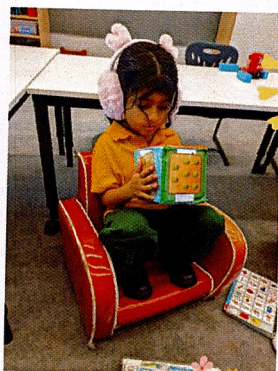
## Classroom 2E

**Water Safety incursion.** Lifeguards came out to teach us about water safety, show us the equipment they use to help keep people safe around water, AND let students play with their equipment!

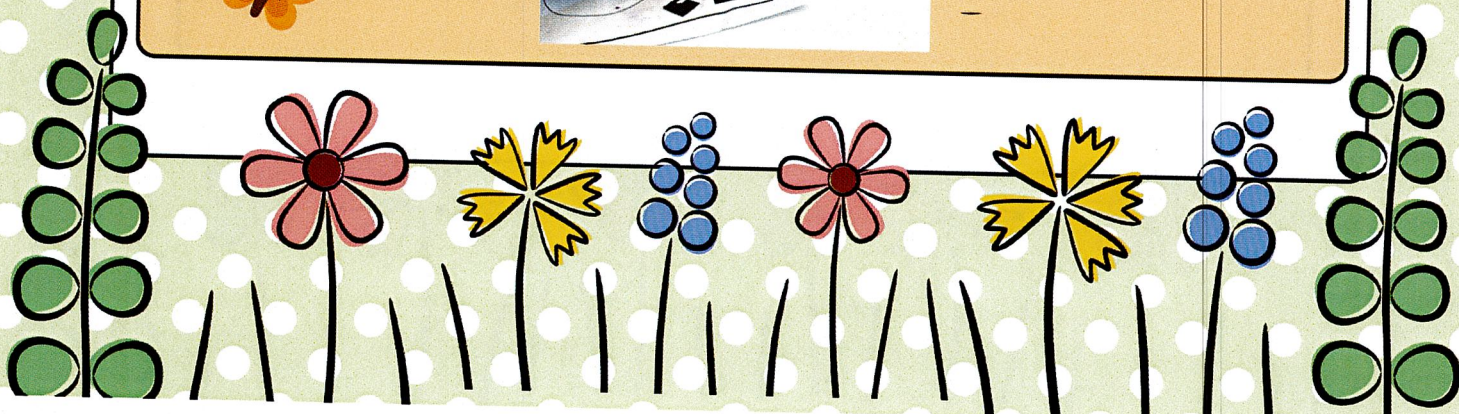
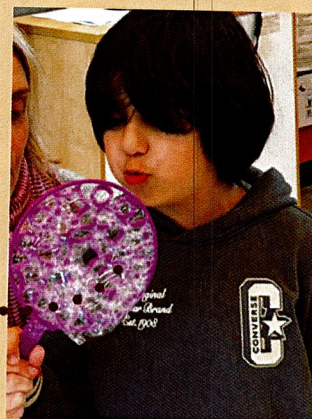
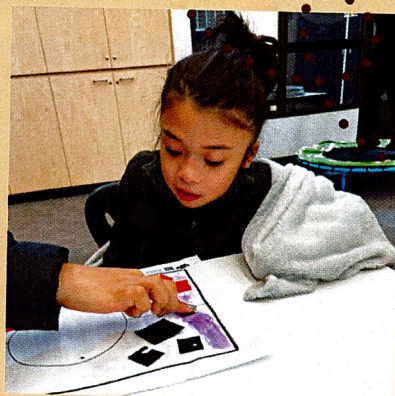
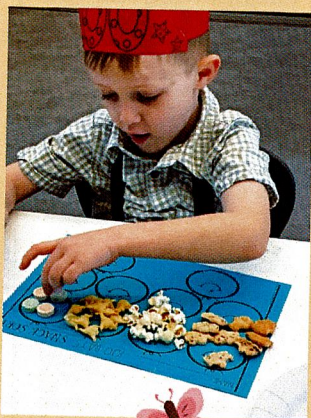
