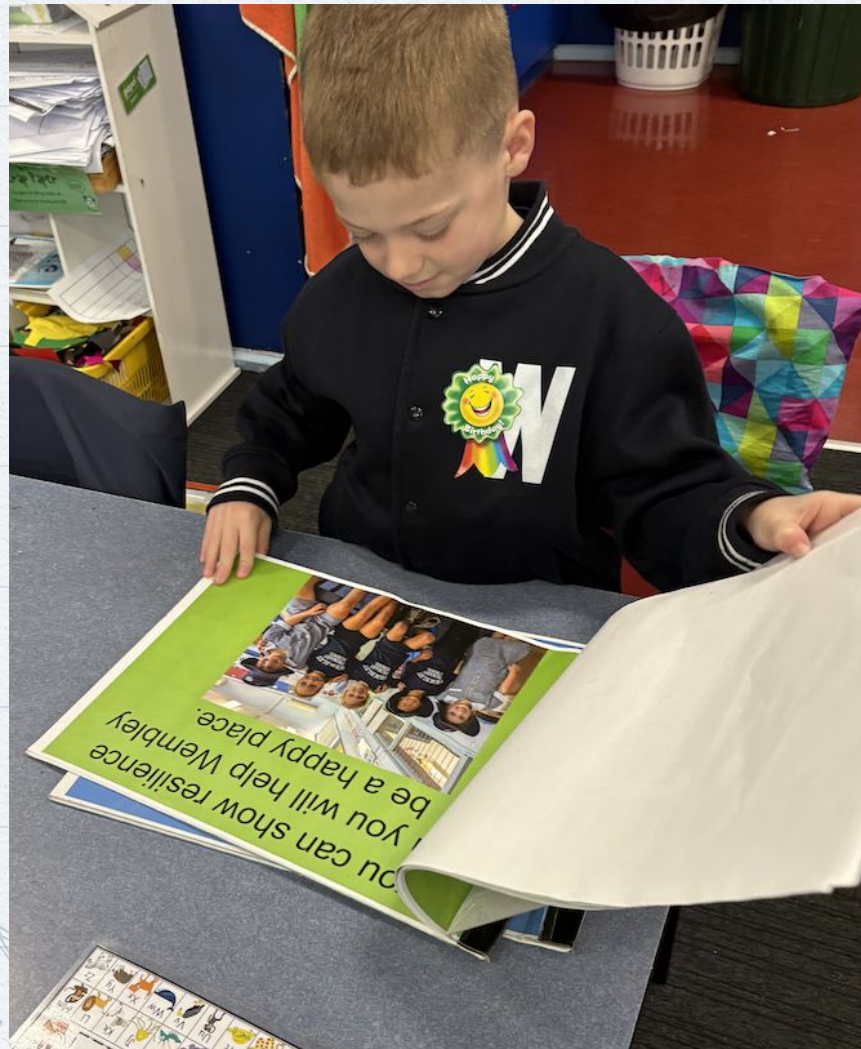
Term 2 Week 6-10 2026: Newsletter

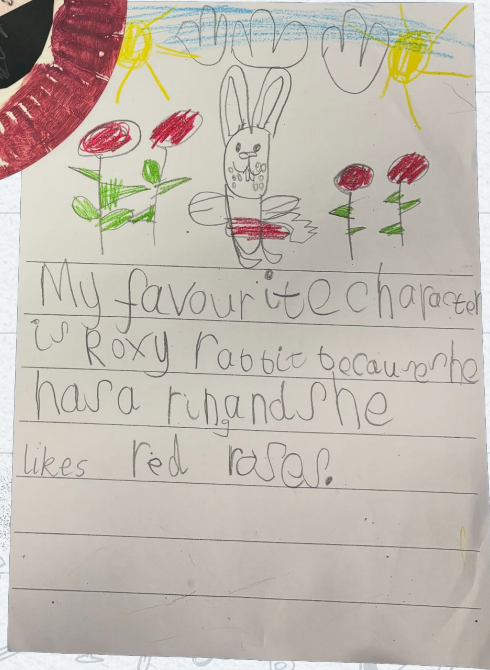
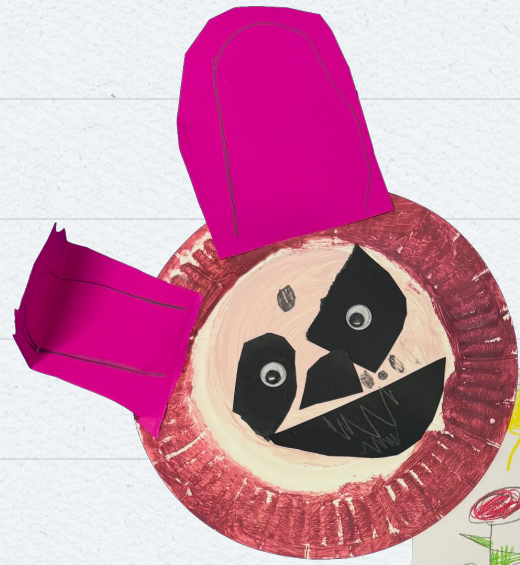
READING

WRITING

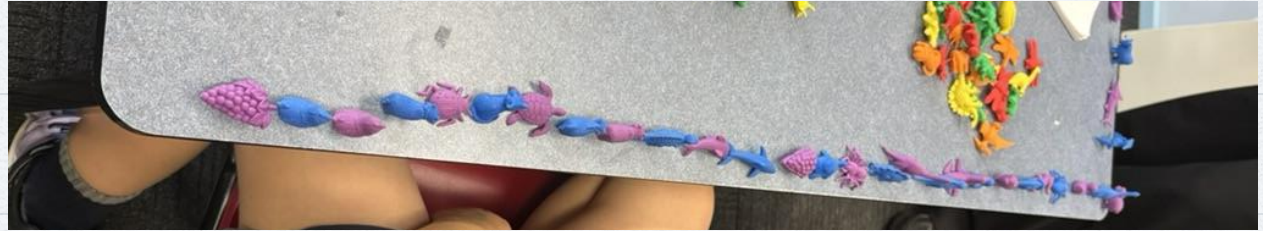
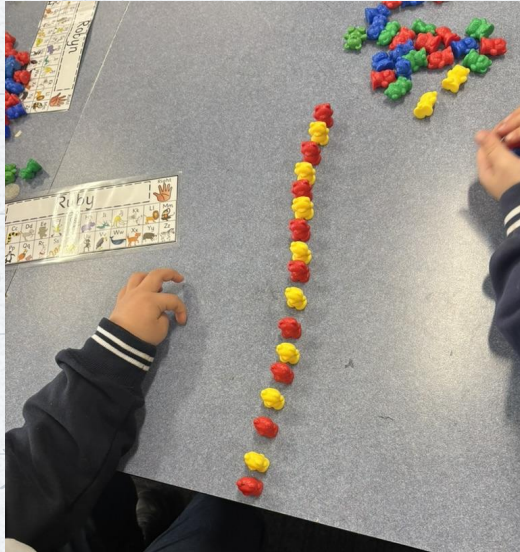
