#### What books can be sold?

- Only those books on the attached list. Note: only the editions and publishers listed can be sold.
- Books must not contain writing in ink. Any pencil markings must be thoroughly erased.

#### What price do I ask?

- We recommend 75% of the new price for excellent condition and 50% for good condition.
- If deemed necessary, prices will be adjusted by the sale coordinator.

#### When do I bring books to school?

- Friday 1 December 2017, 9.30am 2.00pm at the Middle Years Centre.
- Prior to this date books can be left in a bag at the library with textbook submission form and direct deposit form.
- Middle years classes will be allocated time on Friday to drop books off-don't forget to have paperwork completed please.
- Please DO NOT leave CAS calculators at the library. These must be handed in personally on Friday 1 December in the Middle Years Centre.

#### Will I still need my books for class?

No. All teachers are aware that books need to be submitted on this day.

#### How do I buy books?

- Attend the book sale on Saturday 2 December to get first pick of books
- Complete the book request form and books will be selected on your behalf at the end of book sale day.

#### **Unsold books:**

- Tick the box on the form to say you want unsold books returned. Unsold books can be collected from the general office from Wednesday 6 December until Wednesday 13 December 2017. Any unsold books not collected by this time will become the property of PFA.
- Due to time constraints no notification of unsold books will be forwarded. It is the responsibility of the seller to enquire and collect any such books from the College.

#### Payment for sold books:

- You may choose to have the proceeds of your sold books put against your outstanding charges or to be held as a
  credit for upcoming charges. Alternatively, payment can be made by direct deposit into your nominated bank
  account. The payment instruction form must be completed (printing clearly) and submitted.
- The Parents and Friends Association will retain 25% of all sale proceeds as a donation to its fundraising efforts.

### **Second Hand and Digital Reactivation 2018**

As you may be aware, a number of publishers apply a reactivation charge for students who wish to access the digital component when they have purchased a secondhand textbook.

This only applies to second hand books – most new textbooks have digital access for the first year included in the price of the book.

Cambridge University Press	Digital reactivation is free for the life of the edition, EXCEPT all mathematics texts.  Mathematics texts have a digital reactivation charge of \$19.95 for 12 months. This applies to, for example, their <i>Essential Mathematics</i> series, their <i>Cambridge Senior Mathematics</i> series, as well as their other mathematics texts.
Nelson / Cengage	All Nelson textbooks include 4 individual access codes, allowing 4 years
Learning	of digital access to Nelsonnet at no additional cost.
Oxford University	The digital component of all Oxford textbooks lasts for the life of the
Press	book. There are no reactivation charges.
Pearson (including	Digital reactivation for all Pearson textbooks is 50% of the price the same

	For example, the Heinemann Chemistry ebook costs \$51.95, so digital reactivation of a second hand textbook costs \$25.95.

Jacaranda	All Jacaranda texts have a \$50 reactivation charge to provide the full access to LearnON.
	Students that do not pay the \$50 will have access to the LITE version of the ebook. The student will be prompted to pay for this when they login for the first time.
	The <b>LITE version</b> of an <b>eBookPLUS</b> provides access to the digital version of the text online, but does not provide access to any downloadable digital resources, videos, interactive content or interactive questions.
