## Memory Books

This term students will be working hard on their Memory Books. Hopefully over the holidays students have chosen whether they will be presenting their work as an album or using an online program such as Snapfish. Most of the work will be completed at school, however there will be some work that needs to be completed at home.

### **Religion**

In this unit the students will be placing a large focus on morality and justice. Students will be exploring bible stories that link to 'Hope.' They will be connecting how their role as a citizen connects to the Catholic Social Teachings of Jesus. Later in the year, students will be exploring Advent and its connection to Responsibility.

### **Integrated Inquiry**

This term our Integrated Inquiry unit focuses on Hope. It is entitled, 'How can I cultivate and sustain hope in my life, making a difference to myself, others, and the world?' Students will be participating in a program called, 'Genius Hour,' where they will explore an area of interest that relates to Hope.

### <u>English</u>

This term there will be a large focus on editing and revising their work for spelling and grammar. The students will be exploring how they can use specific vocabulary to enhance the quality of their work. They will be participating in Literature Circles this term, exploring a range of new roles. Students will be analysing texts and comparing texts by similar authors.

### **Mathematics**

The students will be focusing on chance. They will be revising BODMAS and using this focus to help to consolidate their learnings in fractions, decimals, and percentages and will use this learn to explore the area of chance. Students will be exploring capacity, mass and volume.

It is important that students continue to strengthen their number facts and multiplication tables. Remember - Mangahigh is always a fantastic resource to use at home.
