



2021 Year 7 Semester 1 Examination Timetable

Year 7 students will complete Semester 1 Examinations from Friday 21 – Tuesday 25 May 2021.

Students will receive an Assessment Task Notification Sheet for each of their examinations to help them prepare.

Examination Instructions

Examination materials.

Students will need to bring pens (blue/black) and a calculator (if necessary) to each examination. These items are to be placed in a clear container/plastic envelope or small pencil case. These may be inspected on entry into the examination room. Students may also bring in a clear drink bottle. No other material will be allowed into the room.

Digital equipment.

Students will not be permitted to bring digital equipment into the examination room except for their calculator. Students will need to leave their mobile phone, smart watch, laptop and any other equipment in their locker or bag.

Silence.

Students will need to remain silent during all examinations. If assistance is needed, students are to raise their hand and wait for the supervisor. Students should not attempt to communicate with any other students during the examination, even when papers are being collected.

Toilet breaks.

Students will not be permitted to go to the bathroom in the *first 30 minutes* or the *last 30 minutes* of any examination.

Normal Timetabled lessons.

Normal timetabled lessons will take place when examinations are not scheduled and students will need to bring in their equipment to these lessons. Students will need to pay careful attention to the rooms indicated on the timetable for their examinations and for room changes to their normal classes.

Non-serious attempts.

Students will need to make their best attempt for each examination. A Letter of Concern will be issued for any non-serious attempt in an examination.

Absence during an examination.

If a student is absent for an examination, their parent/carer is to contact the student's Academic Care Leader (Mrs Ursino) before the examination and submit a medical certificate by the first day back at school. Students will not receive a mark for their examination and will receive a Letter of Concern if they do not follow this procedure. There will not be a formal time for catch-up exams and students will either catch up informally during class or their mark will be estimated based on their other assessments.
