WHAT DOES A SALON ASSISTANT DO?

As a Salon Assistant you will support professional hairdressers and barbers in maintaining and organising work areas and assist with multiple salon or barbershop services, which may include:

- Greeting clients
- Gowning up clients for services
- Assist client's requirements e.g. making refreshments and providing magazines etc.
- Refilling retail shelves and creating a retail display
- Maintain clean and tidy work areas adhering to WHS policies
- Maintenance and cleaning of hairdressing and barbering tools
- Answering the phone and making bookings under supervision
- Taking payment for client services under supervision
- Shampooing client's hair
- Applying treatments and performing scalp and neck massage on clients
- Recommending hair products to clients
- Basic blow drying on clients
- Basic braiding on clients
- Applying semi-permanent, permanent, temporary and non-lift colours on client's hair
- Removing colour and foils from hair.

SCHOOL BASED TRAINEESHIP

(School Based Trainee course fees are fully funded by DTWD)

School Based Trainee: 18 months – 1 day per week in Hairdressing Salon or Barbershop

4 days training @ Taylorweir per Traineeship 3 days assessment workshops @ Taylorweir 8.30am - 4.00pm

As a School Based Trainee you must be employed for a minimum of one day per week in a hairdressing salon or barbershop under a Traineeship Agreement.

Your employer assumes the responsibility of training you in their workplace using learning and tracking resources developed by Taylorweir.

This training is supplemented by Taylorweir training days that you will attend during your traineeship.

Our Certificate II Trainee Coordinator will monitor your progress during your traineeship, and you will undertake your final assessments at Taylorweir.

You will be required to have your own professional salon assistant equipment kit to participate in this course.

VETDSS AND SCHOOL BASED TRAINEESHIP

A NOTE ON WORK PLACEMENT

School Based Trainees are indentured to a hairdressing salon or barbershop. School Based Trainees are employed and are trained in the salon or barbershop. They are paid for the work they perform when they are on their work placement.

VETDSS students are participating in a VET course and are trained at Taylorweir. When VETDSS students are placed in their Host Workplace they are NOT paid for the work they perform as this forms part of their course.


