The <u>Northcote Electorate State School Alliance (NESSA)</u> has been formed by a group of concerned parents, to lobby for school building funding after electorate-wide decades of neglect.

A number of Northcote High School community members are already involved, and we'd love more of our friends from the Northcote High School community to join us.

All the state schools, secondary and primary, in the Northcote electorate are facing the same challenges of out-of-date and poorly maintained buildings and there is currently no transparent strategy to fund completion of approved master plans.

NESSA is calling on the Victorian government to ensure that all the state school facilities in our electorate are fit for purpose and appropriate for 21st century education, and that funding for state school facilities is de-politicised.

Cake stalls, trivia nights, and fetes are great fun but the money they raise won't provide working toilets and proper lighting let alone build modern and inspiring places to learn.

To launch our campaign, NESSA is holding an 'old school' cake stall at the Northcote Town Hall and urge anyone concerned about the standard of public school facilities to come along and show their support.
