## 2019 Essential Standard Learning Items

Dear Parents

Fitzroy Primary School has a system of combined payment for books/stationery and other essential supplies for students. The school purchases the required books and stationery at a bulk discount price to ensure maximum value for your money and provides all students with the same quality brands as their classmates.

Essential Standard Learning Items for students are a critical part of the school budget. Your payment for curriculum supplies enables us to provide the additional resources that enrich the education of your child. This includes:

<b>Maths: Mathletics, PATMaths</b>	<b>\$30.00</b>
<b>English: Reading Eggs, Soundwaves</b>	<b>\$30.00</b>
<b>Science Materials</b>	<b>\$20.00</b>
<b>Art/Craft Materials</b>	<b>\$20.00</b>
<b>Kitchen Program Supplies</b>	<b>\$10.00</b>
<b>Garden Program Supplies</b>	<b>\$10.00</b>
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>\$230.00</b>

***The combined Essential Standard Learning Items cost for 2019 is \$230.00 per student. Subsidies will be available to eligible families, as described below.***

The State Government has given Fitzroy Primary School additional funds for 2019 based on family circumstances. School Council has allocated a portion of this money to assist families who in the past have received CSEF and the remainder to support programs like the Kitchen and Garden Programs that benefit all students. School Council has approved a subsidy of \$170 per eligible student towards the combined Essential Standard Learning Items costs. This means that ***eligible families will only need to pay \$60 per student*** for Essential Standard Learning items.

***You must present your Health Care/Centrelink card to the office to receive this subsidy.***

### ***Other costs in 2019***

During the year, there will be a variety of camps, swimming, sport and excursion/incursions offered to all students. Each of these will have its own costs. If you hold a current health Care/Centrelink card you may be eligible to draw on the CSEF funds that have also been provided to the school for this purpose.

School uniform can be purchased from the Uniform Shop. Uniform costs cannot be covered by the CSEF or the school's funding.

### ***Voluntary contributions***

Many of the programs and projects we are able to offer at Fitzroy Primary School are only made possible through our fundraising efforts and voluntary contributions. Please see attached page for an opportunity to make a voluntary contribution.
