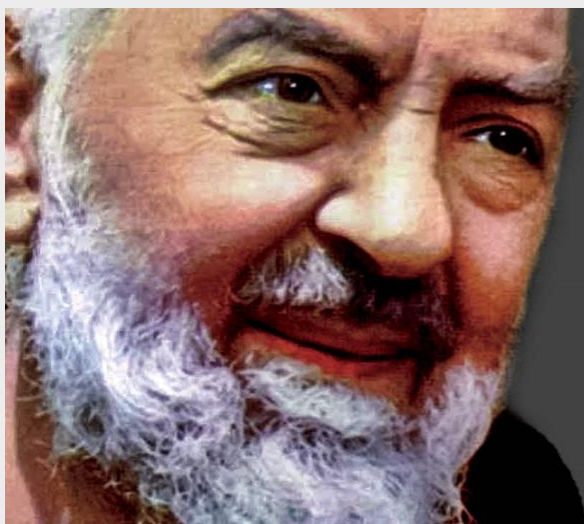

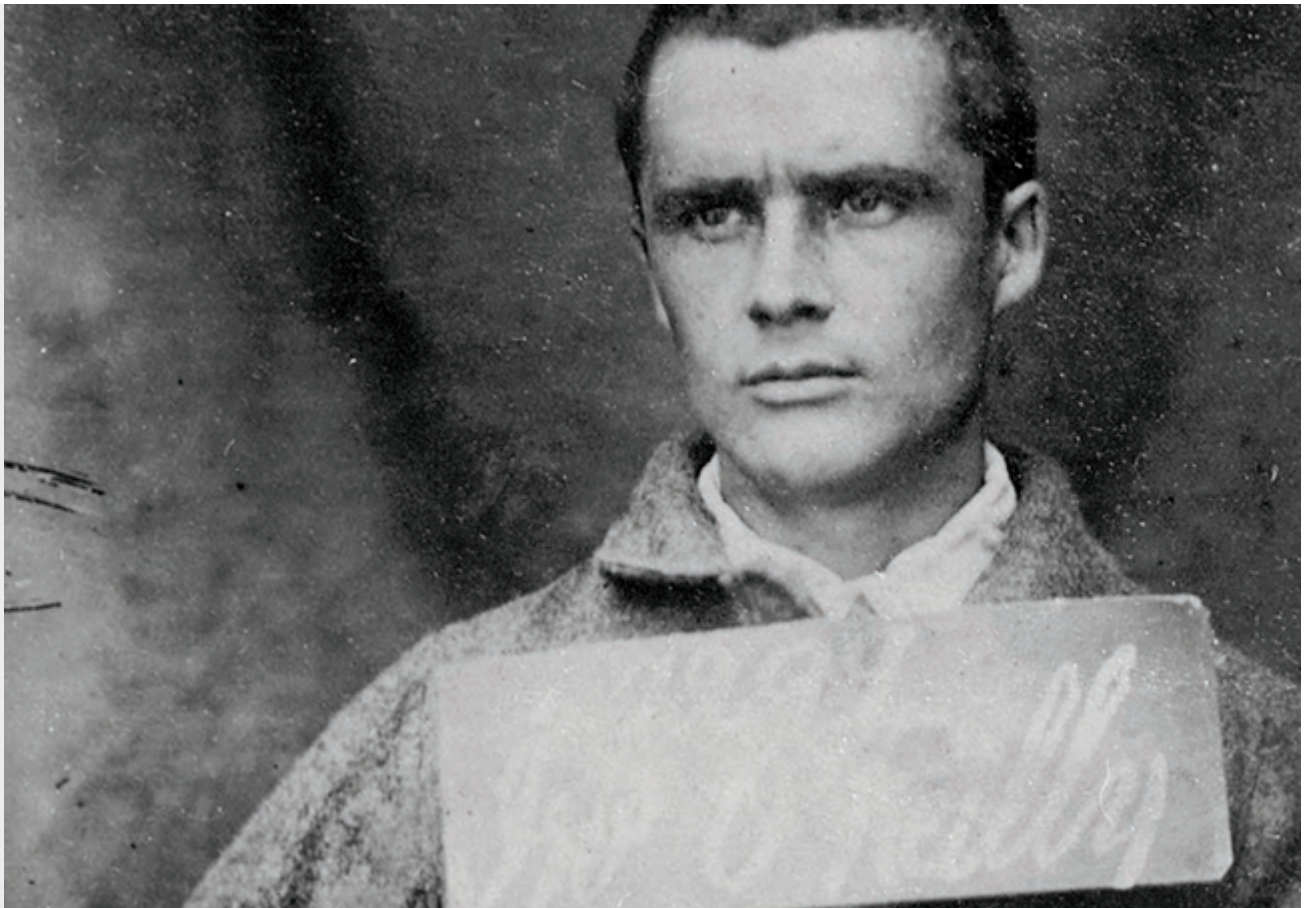


## **MOVIE REVIEW: Time travel enlivens 'Miss Peregrine's Home for Peculiar Children'**
