CHANGE OF PREFERENCE & OFFERS (VICTORIA)

INTRODUCTION

This information is for Year 12 students who have applied for vocational and/or university courses through the Victorian Tertiary Admissions Centre (VTAC).

Change of Preference (CoP) gives you the chance to add, delete and reorder your preferences. If you receive an offer, you will be offered the course highest on your preference list you are eligible for (you have met the ATAR and selection criteria requirements).

It is also the last chance you have to make sure your preference list reflects what you would like to study in the future.

When can I apply?

December 18th offer round: finalise your preferences between now and Saturday 14 December (4pm).

January 15th offer round: finalise your preferences between Wednesday 18 (4pm) - Friday 20 December (4pm).

Tips and hints

- Research your options. Go to CoP information sessions at the institutions of your choice. Use the course search link on the VTAC website.
- New courses: If adding any new courses, make sure you meet the prerequisites
 and have not missed any important dates to hand in supplementary forms or
 book interviews.
- Order correctly: Put in the courses that you really want to get into at the top of your preference list. The lowest ATAR selection ranks won't be determined until January 2020, and could go below the 2019 lowest selection ranks.
- Plan B: Add in plan B courses as backups in case you don't achieve the
 ATAR you need. Research TAFE to university pathway courses, foundation and
 pathway programs at each university and courses with lower ATAR cut-offs,
 which can provide a possible second year transfer.


CHANGE OF PRERERENCE STEPS

1: Assess your preferences

- December 12 (7am) December 14 (4pm): Assess your preferences in light of your results.
- Attend a Change of Preference information day at the institutions you would like to attend, or contact a course adviser via phone or live chat.
- Contact the institutions you would like to study at for advice.
- Firm up your preference list by Saturday 14 December (4pm) via your VTAC account.

2: Change your preferences

- Login to your VTAC account at vtac.edu.au
- If you've forgotten your ID and pin, check your email or use the pin retrieval function
- Click on the Change Undergraduate Preferences link
- Change your preferences (add/delete/re-order) and then click submit.
- You can change your preferences as many times as you like. Note some courses cannot be re-added if you remove them (e.g., medicine).



3: Offers

- December round offers will be released on Wednesday 18 December, https://bit.ly/2oSZOcz
- There will be several offer rounds and you can change your preferences between rounds https://bit.ly/2MFsD1O
- Ensure you accept the offer if you receive one in the December round. This will have no impact on your ability to receive offers in future rounds. For subsequent rounds, you should still have your wish list above your offer in your preference list. If you receive another offer in subsequent rounds and prefer that course, accept it and contact the university or TAFE to cancel the offer/s you have accepted.
