**Week 5**: The Blue Spelling Rule - vowel suffix (When the second last letter makes the sound 'a', 'e', 'i', 'o', 'u' - double the last letter and add the vowel suffix)

Week 6: The Pink Spelling Rule - When a word ends in the graph 'y' - change the 'y to an 'i' and add any suffix except /ing/.
