

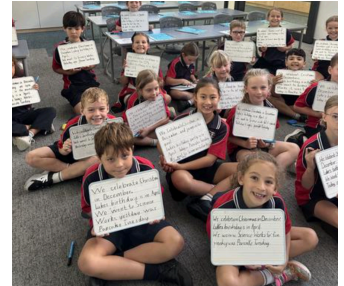
Sacred Heart Year 2, 2026

Welcome to Term 3

MSL

This term, during **Multisensory Structured Learning (MSL)** students will be covering a variety of different spelling rules.

- Vowel teams
- Blending and segmenting sounds
- Recognise how high-frequency words have regular and irregular spelling patterns
- Common digraphs
- Exploring syllable types and patterns
- Silent letters, trigraphs, vowel digraphs and common long vowels
- Learning rules for adding suffixes and prefixes in Morphology



The Writing Revolution

This term we are continuing with our explicit teaching of The Writing Revolution (TWR) lessons focusing on:

- Identifying and using subject and object pronouns
- Identifying and using possessive adjectives and pronouns
- Combining 2-3 sentences with conjunctions and pronouns
- Expanding a simple sentence that begins with a fronted adverbial or adverb
- Using Commas in a List
- Identifying and writing the four sentence types of a statement, command, exclamation and question

We will also complete a novel study focusing on *The Lorax*, examining the structure of a persuasive text through story grammar while engaging with rich and meaningful content.



Mathematics

During Term Three, students will explore:

- **Mass:** students will explore the mass of objects using formal and informal measurements
- **Volume & capacity:** Students will explore volume and capacity by measuring, comparing, and estimating how much different objects and containers hold using informal units
- **Chance:** students will identify whether everyday events are certain, uncertain, possible or impossible to happen
- **Multiplication and division:** students will explore key skills and knowledge related to multiplication and division
- **Operations:** students will explore all four key operations and develop their knowledge of key mathematical concepts



Topic: Solar System, Ötzi the Iceman and Changing Shape

This term, students will explore our solar system, learning about the eight planets, Earth's place in space, and the movements that create patterns in the sky. They will investigate the story of Ötzi the Iceman, using artefacts and historical sources to learn about life over 5,000 years ago. Students will also explore the properties of everyday materials, investigating how they change when bent, twisted or stretched.

Religion

This term in Religious Education, students will explore the unit *Baptism and Belonging*. They will learn that the sacraments are special gifts from God that deepen our friendship with Him. Through a focus on Baptism, students will discover the meaning of the symbols of water, word and welcome, and how Baptism welcomes us into God's family. Throughout the term, students will also continue to nurture their faith through daily prayer and participation in whole-school liturgies and Masses.

Respectful Relationships, Positive Coping and Help Seeking

This term, we will continue our Respectful Relationships lessons and incorporate the Berry Street Education Model into our wellbeing program. Students will explore gender equality, inclusion, human rights, and respectful relationships. They will also develop their understanding of consent, personal rights, and safe and unsafe behaviours.
