DEAR PARISHIONERS, In light of the Premier's Statement and Press Conference, Victoria will enter a Five Day State-wide Lockdown at 11.59pm, 12th February 2021. The Church will be closed. Masses will be livestreamed from Saturday to Wednesday at 9.30am and Sunday at 9.00am.

The Church will not be open for parishioners, Ash Wednesday. Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent. Lent is season of serious Prayers, Fasting and Almsgiving. Mass will be celebrated on Wednesday at 9.30am and live streamed. This is not a holy day of obligation; however, it is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat. Catholics who have completed their 18th year and have not yet begun their 60th year are obliged to Fast. In addition, all Catholics who have completed their 14th year are obliged to Abstain from meat.

Seven additional Catechists are needed to help, with RE Classes in term two. If you are able to help or would like more information please contact Sr Faustina.

FIRST READING

Leviticus 13:1-2.44-46

The Lord said to Moses and Aaron, 'If a swelling or scab or shiny spot appears on a man's skin, a case of leprosy of the skin is to be suspected. The man must be taken to Aaron, the priest, or to one of the priests who are his sons.

'The man is leprous: he is unclean. The priest must declare him unclean; he is suffering from leprosy of the head. A man infected with leprosy must wear his clothing torn and his hair disordered; he must shield his upper lip and cry, "Unclean, unclean." As long as the disease lasts he must be unclean; and therefore he must live apart; he must live outside the camp.'

'Be cured!' And the leprosy left him at once and he was cured. Jesus immediately sent him away and sternly ordered him, `Mind you say nothing to anyone, but go and show yourself to the priest, and make the offering for your healing prescribed by Moses as evidence of your recovery.' The man went away, but then started talking about it freely and telling the story everywhere, so that Jesus could no longer go openly into any town, but had to stay outside in places where nobody lived.
