We are learning all about double letter graphemes, two letters that make one sound! We have learnt that if you see a double letter, we just say the sound once (not twice). We also have learnt the spelling rule to use doubles at the end of words (like hill) and singles at the beginning of words (like leg). We have now learnt three double letter graphemes /ss/, /ff/ and /ll/.

For our first Big Write on Thursday, we are going to use the picture 'Up the Hill' as a prompt for the students to celebrate their learning. This task will focus on the /ll/ grapheme.

With your child, please talk about some sentence ideas they would like to write about that include some of the words above. Please don't write the story at home, this is an oral language exercise. Thank you and have fun!
