
Getting here

Palm Beach Aquatic & Community Centre is located on **Thrower Drive, Palm Beach.**

Carparking is available on site, however we recommend using public transport, cycling or carpooling where possible. Plan your public transport journey using the **TransLink journey** planner.

Where is the carpark located?

The carpark is located underneath Palm Beach Aquatic & Community Centre. **Entrance is via Thrower Drive.**



How many carparks are available?

139 carparks are available at the centre.

- 116 standard carparks
- 15 small carparks
- 8 accessible carparks

Are there any alternative parking options nearby if the carpark is full?

Yes, additional free parking is available at:

- Thrower Drive
- Salk Oval
- Thrower Drive Boat Ramp
- Leyte Avenue
- Sarawak Avenue
- Laguna Avenue

Please refer to the map attached for all nearby parking options.

Is there a drop off zone?

Yes, there is a 2 minute drop off zone located at the front of the centre along Thrower Drive.

What are the centre carparking hours?

The centre carpark is available during centre opening hours only. Opening hours are subject to change pending events and bookings at Palm Beach Aquatic & Community Centre. Restricted access will prevent cars from entering and exiting the car park when the centre is closed.

Who can park at Palm Beach Aquatic and Community Centre?

Centre carparking is strictly reserved for users of Palm Beach Aquatic & Community Centre only. The City reserves the right to arrange for any unauthorised vehicles to be towed.

Is there a fee for parking?

Parking is available to users of Palm Beach Aquatic & Community Centre only.

Are there designated accessible carparks for visitors?

Yes, the carpark has eight accessible carparks available to visitors. Accessible carparks are located near the lifts.

What is the maximum vehicle height allowed in the carpark?

The maximum vehicle height is 2.2 metres. Accessible carparks have a vehicle height of 2.5 metres.

Can I reserve a carpark in advance?

No, parking cannot be reserved. We recommend arriving early to allow ample time for parking.

Is there overnight parking available?

No, the carpark will only remain open during centre opening hours. Restricted access will prevent cars from entering and exiting the car park when the centre is closed. The City reserves the right to arrange for any unauthorised vehicles to be towed.

Are there bike racks available for cyclists?

Yes, there are bike racks available for cyclists located at the front of the centre on Thrower Drive.

Where is the closest bus stop to the centre?

There are three TransLink bus routes that stop directly out the front of the centre.
